Religion: It's Advent! We discussed that Advent is a time to prepare for Christmas. We read the Annunciation story- when the angel Gabriel announces the birth of Jesus to Mary. We learned Christmas is the celebration of Jesus's birthday and that He came as our Savior. We learned that St. Nicholas loved others by giving his money secretly to the poor.

Math: We played lots of games to review numbers 1-10. We played "Bears in a cave" where students close their eyes and count silently as I put bears in a cup. AABB is our new pattern and we used movements to make this pattern.

Literacy: This week we learned about the letter G and the sound it makes. We learned that names always begin with a capital letter. We read some Christmas stories like, "The Night the Saints saved Christmas," "Mr. Willowby's Tree," "The Story of Christmas," "What can I give Jesus?", and "Saint Nicholas: The real story of the Christmas legend."
