Religion:

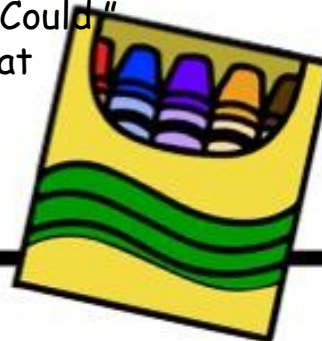
We read "You are Special" by Max Lucado and talked about how God made us. Because of that, every person is special. Each student made an I'm Special book!
