Teacher Message

Hello K5 parents!

This week our focus is on firefighters and fire safety.

Literacy: This week, we are reading stories that help us learn more about firefighters and fire safety! We are practicing to ask and answer questions about the text. We thought about different questions based on the cover and title of the book. We then tried to find the answers in the story.

Religion: This week we read the Bible story about Noah's Ark. We learned that we should also be obedient to God and that God promised he wouldn't flood the earth again and the rainbow reminds us of that promise.

Math: We finished up our unit on comparing numbers to 5. We learned to compare groups or sets using the words greater than, less than, or the same as. We learned to explain why we thought that a group was that

Social Studies: This week our focus is learning about fire safety. We are talking about what firefighters wear, use, and do during a fire. We talked about what we should do when there is a fire and how to stay safe.

Since we have a short week, I have sent home a fire safety booklet and other activities that you and your child can do. Discuss what fire safety procedures you have in your home.
