Hello K5 Families!

This month we are focusing on holidays around the world. This is our last week learning about the holiday traditions all around the world. We are learning how they are similar to and different from our family traditions.

Literacy: Our stories this week are focused on traditions and information about the certain country we are traveling to. On Monday, we read a story about what children do in Sweden to celebrate the Christmas season.. Tuesday, we read the Legend of the Candy Cane and how it reminds us of Jesus.
