Teacher Message

Hello K5 Families!

Literacy and Science: This week we are reading a chapter book called Mrs. Piggie Wiggle. (As a child, this was one of my favorite books to read and listen to.) We have been practicing describing the main character's appearance based on the description given in the book. We are also describing the character's personality and how they might change throughout the chapter. In science, we have been learning about the states of matter. We learned that there are 3 states of matter; solid, liquid, and gas. We have loved exploring and doing experiments that show us the 3 states of matter. We will continue to experiment more next week.

Religion: This week we learned about the miracle of when Jesus walked on water and Peter went out to meet him, walking on the water but started to sink as his faith grew weak. We learned about the Prodigal Son and how the father forgave his son even though he didn't make the best choices. Just like the father in the story, God will always forgive us when we make bad choices. God always wants us to be close to Him. Our saint of the week is St. Rose of Lima. This week, we are continuing our walk with Jesus on His Journey to death through the Stations of the Cross. We are focused on Station 7: Jesus falls for the second time. Station 8: Jesus meets the women and children.

Math: We started our unit on shapes. This week we have focused on identifying and describing circles and squares. We have learned that they are 2D shapes, which means they are flat. We learned how to describe a circle as round and having a curve. With a square we learned that it has 4 straight sides and 4 corners. We will continue our exploration of shapes in the next few weeks.

Extra Clothes: Even with the weather changing, it is still a good thing to have extra pants, shirt, underwear and socks here at school. Sometimes the students will step in a puddle, slide down a wet slide, or fall in the mud. Please make sure your student has those extra items in their backpack.
