**Literacy:** We are reading books by Dr. Seuss this week. On Monday, we were able to identify the real words and nonsense words that rhymed. On Tuesday, we listened for and identified all the opposite words. On Wednesday, we learned about the importance of reading and how reading can take you on many adventures but you have to keep your eyes open. We went on a reading adventure in our school, finding all the different places we could read. On Thursday, we learned that we can go anywhere and be anything we want and to never give up on our dreams. On Friday, we will be comparing the Cat in the Hat and the Cat in the Hat Comes Back to see how they are the same and different.

**Religion:** This week Our saint of the week is St. Dominic Savio. He was a boy who loved God so much and was not afraid to tell others when they were doing bad things.
