Literacy: This week, we read stories that help us learn more about pumpkins. We continued to practice identifying the sequence of the story, using the words beginning, middle, and end.

Science: This week, we focused on the life cycle of a pumpkin.

Religion: This week we learned about St. Teresa of Avila. She was the first woman to be named Doctor of the Church. We learned about the virtue of humility. We talked about how humility is not bragging about something but we could instead cheer on others in their achievements.

Additional Reminders:
