Teacher Message

Hello K5 parents!

This week our focus is on firefighters and fire safety.

Literacy: This week, we are reading stories that help us learn more about firefighters and fire safety! We are practicing to ask and answer questions about the text. We thought about different questions based on the cover and title of the book. We then tried to find the answers in the story. **Social Studies:** This week our focus is learning about fire safety. We are talking about what firefighters wear, use, and do during a fire. We talked about what we should do when there is a fire and how to stay safe.

Religion: This week we learned about St. Therese the Little Flower. She lived in France and had the goal to always try to do little acts of kindness with great love for God.

Math: We finished up our unit on comparing numbers to 5. We learned to compare groups or sets using the words greater than, less than, or the same as. Review comparing groups of objects at home. Ask questions like which group has more or is greater? Which group has less or fewer? Are the groups equal? Have your student make groups and tell you about the groups he/she made.
