Teacher Message

Hello K5 Families!

Science & Literacy: As we read our stories this week, we are looking to describe how the illustrations and text help us to better understand the story. Each story helped us to better understand what living things need to survive. We are learning about the things that living things need to survive and how living things are alike and different.

Religion: We learned about St. Helena and how she found the True Cross that Jesus died on. We read the bible story about Jesus being presented in the temple. We talked about how God always keeps his promises even if it takes a long time. We also read the Bible story about Daniel and how he always put God first even though he would get in trouble. We talked about how Jesus always wants to stay close to us and be our friend.

Math: We are continuing our work on subtraction. We have been looking at the different ways we can subtract from a bigger number. For example, $5 - 1 = 4$, $5 - 3 = 2$, etc...
