Literacy/Social Studies: This week we started learning about American Symbols. We learned that a symbol is a representation of something else. For example, the Crucifix is a symbol of Jesus's death on the cross. We are first focusing on the president and how the president can be a symbol of the United States. We are going to learn more specifically about George Washington and Abraham Lincoln.

Religion: Our saint of the week is St. Scholastica. She was the twin sister of St. Benedict. We learned about Ash Wednesday and Lent. This is the time of prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and repentance. During Lent we will be learning about and praying the Stations of the Cross. This week, we are focusing on Station 1, Pilate Condemns Jesus and Station 2, Jesus Carries the Cross.
