Teacher Message

Hello K5 Families!

Literacy/Social Studies: This week we are learning about weather. We have been reading stories that talk about the weather and the different seasons. We are learning to be weather watchers and how to check the 4 different things that will tell us about the weather. First, we have to check if it is sunny or cloudy. Next, we check to see if it is windy or not. 3rd, we check to see if there is any precipitation (rain or snow). Last, we check the temperature by thinking about the clothes we need to wear outside. We are learning about all sorts of different types of weather and what to do when there is severe weather. We learned the 4 seasons are based on the movement of the earth around the sun. We also talked about how and why the weather changes in each of those seasons.

Religion: This week we learned about St. Kateri Tekakwitha, she was the first Native American to be declared a saint. We also talked about the virtue of loyalty and how we can be loyal to our family, friends, God, and those who are experiencing injustices.

Math: We are finishing up our unit on subtraction. Next week we will start our new unit learning about 2D and 3D shapes.
