Teacher Message

Hello K5 parents!

Literacy: This week, we are reading stories that help us learn more apples. We are learning to identify the characters in each of the stories. When you read stories at home, have your student try and identify the characters in the story. We have been learning about what a noun is and when a noun is plural or singular.

Science: This week our focus is learning about apples. We are learning about the life cycle of an apple and about the parts of an apple. We will also compare apples and see how they taste.

Religion: This week we learned that Jesus speaks to us through the Holy Bible. We also talked about how we can pray to God in many different places. We also read the Bible story of Adam and Eve and learned about how we should always be obedient to God. This week, our saint is St. Robert Bellarmine. He is the patron saint of catechists. We learned about the virtue of faith and how we should always believe and trust in God even when it is hard.

Math: We are learning about counting to 5, to show up to 5 objects, and to recognizing numerals and number words to 5. Give your student opportunities to count out items to 5 and beyond. Example, have your student help set the table. Ask them how they know how many places to set for your family.
