## Teacher Message

Hello K5 parents!

**Literacy and Social Studies:** This week, we are reading stories that help us learn more about community helpers! We are continuing our focus on finding the main idea and what key details help us understand an informational or fictional text. During writing time we are working on writing a short sentence and drawing a picture to match. We watched videos and did fun guessing games to figure out what community helper we are learning about.

**Religion:** We learned about St. Padre Pio and the many gifts that God gave him, including the stigmata and the ability to bi-located and levitate. The virtue of the week is piety. We talked about how we should show reverence and respect to God by making time for Him throughout our day. We also talked about making sure we make the Sign of the Cross and genuflect with reverence.

**Math:** We are reviewing counting to 5, to show up to 5 objects, and to recognizing numerals and number words to 5. We are learning to compare numbers to 5. Which numbers are greater than or less than.
