

Reflections from the Gloria Dei Choir

*Though I may speak with
bravest fire,
And have the gift to all inspire,
And have not love; my words are vain,
As sounding brass and hopeless gain.*

This paraphrase of St. Paul's message to the Corinthians resounds on this Sixth Sunday of Easter as we hear about love throughout our readings: God's love for us, and how we should love one another. The first anthem the choir will present uses this text in "The Gift of Love," arranged by Hal H. Hopson. The melody is based on an old Scottish folk tune, "O Waly, Waly," also known as "The Water is Wide." Hopson, who has written over 800 compositions, expands it into a lush piece for choir and organ in this arrangement. Once again, we are reminded of our baptism as we hear the flowing of water in the organ part. We also foreshadow the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost in a mere two weeks with the words, "Come, spirit, come, our hearts control. Our spirits long to be made whole. Let inward love guide every deed. By this we worship and are freed." The sacraments are also brought to fulfillment this weekend as we welcome First Communicants at our Masses; the Eucharist is truly our greatest Gift of Love.

*O God beyond all praising, we worship you today
and sing the love amazing that songs cannot repay;
for we can only wonder at every gift you send,
at blessings without number and mercies without end:
We lift our hearts before you and wait upon your Word,
we honor and adore you, our great and mighty Lord.*

The second choral anthem this morning is an arrangement by Richard Proulx of the main majestic melody by Gustav Holst (1874-1934) from the "Jupiter" movement of his masterpiece, *The Planets*, which is also known as the hymn tune called "Thaxted." The text was written by Michael Perry, who served as Vicar of Tonbridge and a canon of Rochester Cathedral in England, as a "response to a call for alternative words that would be more appropriate for Christian worship," as the original hymn text was a patriotic poem, "I Vow to Thee My Country." The second verse was an addition requested by Proulx, a Catholic, who created the arrangement we hear this morning. It is an a cappella segment of the piece that recounts the death and resurrection: "For Christ the man from heaven from death has set us free, and we through him are given the final victory." The organ continues and builds the theme as it crescendos, leading to the final verse with a high soprano descant soaring over the melody being sung by the rest of the choir. The text of this added verse comes from 1 Corinthians, only two chapters away from the text we heard in our first piece. "Then hear, O gracious Savior, accept the love we bring."




