Service Reflection Form – Indirect Service for Social Justice

As part of the Confirmation process, you are required to do service in various areas, one of which is indirect service for social justice. This service could be participating in a Walk for Life or any other walk that raises money for a Social Justice issue, Operation Sandwich, organizing a way to raise money and then give that money to a Social Justice organization.
