Service Reflection Form – Helping provide money and other material support for the parish

As part of the Confirmation process, you are required to do service in various areas, one of which is providing money and other material support for the parish. This does not mean just handing money to the parish and your service is done. This service could be working at a fundraiser, getting a donor to donate money or goods for a particular event, or working La Fiesta. You must do this type of service twice over the course of the two-year process and each time needs to be at least 2 hours of service. Please read the Scripture passage and Canon Law selection below before you complete your service, get your supervisor to sign this paper, and then go back and re-read the selections and answer the questions below.
