## Qualifications for Confirmation Sponsors

- It is desirable that the one who undertook the role of sponsor at baptism be the sponsor for confirmation.
- A non-Catholic may NOT be a confirmation sponsor.
- Must be designated by the one to be Confirmed.
- Must be at least **eighteen** years of age.
- Be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist and leads a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken: The sponsor is actively participating and living the Catholic faith through attending Mass and trying to live a lifestyle that professes the Gospels.
- Not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared: The sponsor is in good standing with the Church.
- Not be the father or mother of the one to be confirmed.
- A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community may not be admitted except as a witness to baptism and together with a Catholic sponsor. The Confirmation sponsor must be Catholic.

## Responsibilities of the Confirmation Sponsor

- Attend all rights and Rituals and liturgies as listed on the Master Calendar with your candidate.
- Attend all Scheduled Sponsor/Candidate meetings as listed on Master Calendar.
- Contact your candidate at least once a month to check in on them and see how they are doing in all aspects of their lives.
- Continue to journey with them after they have received their Confirmation, this is a life long journey, not a two year process.
