### How Should We Prepare For This Great Feast Of Mercy?



Jesus told St. Faustina that this **Feast of Mercy** would be a special day when all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (699) I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy" (Diary 1109). Confession should be as close to the feast day as possible. We want to encourage everyone to take advantage of this incredible promise and the additional Plenary Indulgence of this great Feast of Mercy on "Divine Mercy Sunday". **Merciful Acts Are The Corporal And Spiritual Works Of Mercy** "I demand from you deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse yourself from it" (742). How do we "radiate" God's mercy to others? By our actions, our words, and our prayers." (742) "Judgment is without mercy to one who has shown no mercy" (Jas 2:13). "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespasses against us" (Mt 6:12-14).

**At 3 O'clock**, implore My mercy, especially for sinners. Immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. In this hour I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion. Jesus told St. Faustina "This is the **HOUR OF GREAT MERCY**" (Diary 1320).

**Novena and Chaplets** "Whoever will recite the Chaplet will receive great mercy at the hour of death" (687). Through the Chaplet will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will" (1731) The devotion begins on Good Friday.

**The Image of The Divine Mercy**, which Our Lord requested to be solemnly blessed and venerated on this day, will be on display in our church. St. John Paul II said that the image portrays the Risen Jesus Christ bringing Mercy to the whole world. Jesus said "I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it" I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish". (Diary 341, 48) "The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the cross." (Diary 299) I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature:

"Jesus, I Trust in You". (Diary 327)

**"Divine Mercy Sunday"**, Jesus said to St. Faustina, "...tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out an ocean of graces upon the souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as great.... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy". (Diary 699)
