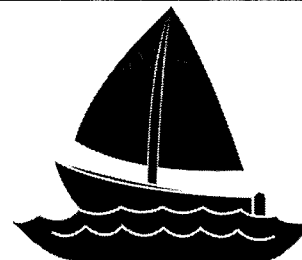

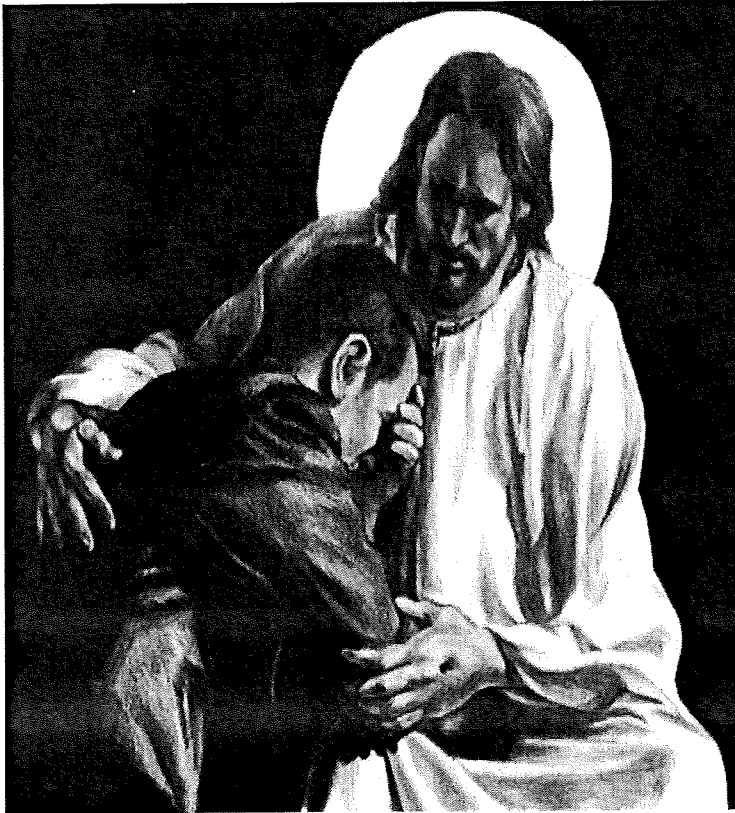

## WHY GO TO CONFESSION?

Jesus entered this world to forgive sins. Recall the words of our Lord: "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him may not die but may have eternal life." (Jn 3:16) During His public ministry, Jesus preached about the forgiveness of sins: the parables of the Prodigal Son (Lk 15:11ff) or the Lost Sheep (Lk 15:1ff). Jesus Himself forgave sins: remember the story of the woman caught in adultery (Jn 8:1ff) or the woman who washed His feet with her tears. (Lk 7:36ff) He also taught us to pray for forgiveness in the "Our Father:" "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." His mission of reconciliation would climax in His passion, death and resurrection: Jesus suffered, died and rose to free us from sin and death.

The Devil wants us to believe that sinning is no big deal or when we realize how harmful our sin is that we are worthless and unforgivable. Confessing our sins can be terrifying but God is All-Powerful. This means, that by virtue of His very essence, there is no sin too great for God to forgive!

Why a priest? The sacrament of reconciliation was instituted by Christ Himself (John 20:23). In confessing to someone standing in the Person of Christ, we are humbling ourselves and acknowledging how desperately we need Him. And in the sacrament, we get absolute assurance that we are forgiven.
