St. Ignatius ECC Emergency Procedures

General Emergency Information:

- School Crisis Plans are posted in each classroom and the ECC Office. Crisis plans are reviewed frequently with the staff and Crisis Response Team.
- Tornado, hurricane and fire drill procedures are to be posted by each classroom door.
- Parents are notified of the disaster plan and the procedures to follow in our Parent Handbook.
- In case of inclement weather or other emergencies, St. Ignatius ECC will follow the public school decision to close schools, and use our Honeywell instant alert to notify the parents.

Emergency Evacuation Plan:

- In the event a disaster such as a hurricane, tornado or other catastrophe strikes our building, the staff will move the children to the Parish Hall.
- In the event that the Parish Hall is hit, the staff will escort the children to the Church. Parents coming to the property in the event of an emergency located at the preschool should use the church parking lot and walk to the school. This will keep the lot clear for emergency vehicles.
- In the event a disaster strikes requiring relocation, the staff and children will be taken to the Parish Hall or the Church.
- The staff will use the Emergency Contact information provided by parents for reunification with children at the onsite or offsite locations.
- Staff will use the emergency go boxes to meet the needs of all children including children with special needs or medical conditions during and following an emergency event.
- This emergency evacuation plan is designated as a preventative and informative statement to all concerned: parish staff, parents, school personnel and child license board.
