
#### **Baptism**

Dear Parishioners:

The season of Lent has been an important time in the life of each of us here at Holy Apostles Parish. It began very dramatically with the reception of ashes, in a sense, marking us as God's people. The first week of March our Parish Mission called all members of Holy Apostles to a deeper relationship with our loving God. On this weekend we receive palms, which remind us of the people's love for Jesus - a love that turned to hate and indifference, quite rapidly. The special practices of Lent....added prayer, fasting, almsgiving... remind us that this was no ordinary time. Because Lent is a season with a personality of its own, we tend to think of it as a season, which has its existence just for the sake of itself. However, it is important to remind ourselves that Lent exists only as a preparation for something bigger. That something bigger is the Easter Triduum.

The term Easter Triduum might not sound familiar to you; however, you are very familiar with it. The Triduum is the three-day celebration of the death and resurrection of Christ - Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil/Easter Sunday. The Church meets at times during those three days to remember what it is that Jesus has done for us. During this most solemn of weeks, I invite all the members of our Parish Family to join us for the solemn observance of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. These days of Holy Week offer us a rare opportunity to renew our faith in the Lord who died for us. If you have never attended these services before, or if it has been many years since you attended them, this would be a good year to make a special effort to attend. It will be an experience for you and your family to see and participate in the beauty of these days, when the Church invites us to share in the fullness of Joy which the Resurrection brings to us. Let us complete Lent as a parish family by renewing our faith together during Holy Week.

On Palm Sunday 2021, Pope Francis said in his homily: "Every year this liturgy leaves us amazed: we pass from the joy of welcoming Jesus as he enters Jerusalem to the sorrow of watching him condemned to death and then crucified. That sense of interior

amazement will remain with us throughout Holy Week. Let us reflect more deeply on it.

From the start, Jesus leaves us amazed. His people give him a solemn welcome, yet he enters Jerusalem on a lowly colt. His people expect a powerful liberator at Passover, yet he comes to bring the Passover to fulfillment by sacrificing himself. His people are hoping to triumph over the Romans by the sword, but Jesus comes to celebrate God's triumph through the cross. What happened to those people who in a few days' time went from shouting "Hosanna" to crying out "Crucify him"? What happened? They were following an idea of the Messiah rather than the Messiah. They admired Jesus, but they did not let themselves be amazed by him. Amazement is not the same as admiration. Admiration can be worldly, since it follows its own tastes and expectations. Amazement, on the other hand, remains open to others and to the newness they bring. Even today, there are many people who admire Jesus: he said beautiful things; he was filled with love and forgiveness; his example changed history... and so on. They admire him, but their lives are not changed. To admire Jesus is not enough. We have to follow in his footsteps, to let ourselves be challenged by him; to pass from admiration to amazement." of a deceased loved one. A special Memorial Mass will be said on **April 24**, **2023**.


#### **EASTER COLLECTION**
