# From the Pastor

Dear Friends,

On Monday, May 1<sup>st</sup> it was announced that Pope Francis had accepted the resignation of Bishop Thomas J. Tobin from pastoral governance of the Diocese of Providence. As Coadjutor Bishop, Bishop Richard G. Henning automatically succeeds him effective immediately.

I join with the faithful of Holy Apostles Parish as we thank Bishop Tobin for his 18 years of dedicated leadership and his faithfulness in preaching the Gospel. He has lived the example of the Good Shepherd in our local Church. As Bishop Henning begins his ministry as the 9th Bishop of Providence, we offer him our prayers and support. May the virtue of hope, along with faith and charity, guide his episcopacy.

The readings for the last few Sundays have been about the Resurrection, but today's Gospel takes us back in time to an event in Jesus' life before his Passion. Jesus tells his disciples that he is going to prepare a place for them in his Father's house. He promises that where he is going, his disciples will be able to follow. Thomas, who will later doubt the disciples' reports that they have seen the Risen Lord, contradicts Jesus by saying that the disciples don't know where Jesus is going or how to get there. Jesus explains that he himself is the way, the truth, and the life. In knowing and loving Jesus, the disciples now love God the Father.

Philip then makes a request that challenges Jesus' words. Philip wants Jesus to show the Father to the disciples. Recall that Jesus has just told his disciples, "If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him." As a good teacher, Jesus responds to Philip by repeating and elaborating on what he has just told the disciples: they have seen and known Jesus, so they have seen and known the Father. Then Jesus offers another reassurance about his departure: because of faith in God and in

Jesus, the disciples will do the work that Jesus has done and more.

The connection between Jesus and his Father, between Jesus' work and the work of the Father, is made clear in today's Gospel. Jesus is in the Father, and God the Father is in Jesus. As God spoke his name to Moses, "I am," so too Jesus speaks his name to his disciples: "I am the way and the truth and the life."

The revelation of the Trinity is completed in the passage that follows today's reading, and it is the Gospel for next Sunday. Because Jesus goes away, the Father will send in Jesus' name the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who will continue the work of the Father and of Jesus.

I extend Congratulations to those children that received First Holy Communion on Saturday!

Also, a special thanks to all that made last Sunday's welcome of Bishop Henning and the blessing of the "Homeless Jesus Bench" such a beautiful and memorable occasion. It was a great showing of the vitality and faith of the people of Holy Apostles Parish.




