From the Pastor

Dear Friends,

This weekend we are celebrating the Sunday between the Ascension of our Lord and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, next Sunday. It is still Paschal or Eastertide, but it is rapidly coming to an end. On the other hand, Easter never ends and is a mystery ever-present, since we live now and always in the light of the Lord's resurrection. The Gospel text this weekend is taken from our Lord's Last Supper discourse, also called Christ's High Priestly Prayer, that eloquent text from the Gospel according to Saint John, concerning Jesus' glorification, that is, his being raised on high by God. But we might ask: what precisely is this glory? It is none other than the victory over sin and death, by means of dying on the cross. How does the cross reveal or lead to Christ's glory? In the cross we find the depth of God's infinite love for sinners, the human race, and at the same time the power of God to redeem us by canceling the debt of sin and reversing the ancient curse of separation from God. In other words, the goal of intimacy with the Trinity, our origin and goal, is made possible by God's saving deeds in and through the risen savior, Jesus Christ.

To possess eternal life is to have God's life within us. That's not about time, but about time transcended. It is about participation in God's peace, joy, love and holiness that God possesses to an infinite degree, and we to lesser a degree, but participants we are, nonetheless. Jesus makes it possible for each of us personally to participate in divine life, beginning now and not ending with death. Jesus is God's perfect love manifest in the flesh. Jesus reveals God's majesty and glory and is saying to each of us here and now: "You also can be a part of this greatness. Let go and let God enter your life." We are being told in Scripture, in the sacred liturgy, to rejoice, to have a conviction of faith, that we have not been left orphans, but have God's life always nearby. We share in Christ's sufferings, but we are not put to shame.

Our tiny drop of life is an important part of the ocean of God's goodness, from where has come the tiny drop of our life, and to where we are being led back by our God who loves us without bounds.

Our Lord has ascended but remains with us in a new and even more powerful way. At Pentecost the fullness of God's help comes to us as the Holy Spirit is poured out on the Church. We have been or will be anointed with the Holy Spirit in a special way in the Sacraments. To put it simply, the Lord desires to remain with us under many forms, throughout our life, including the gift of his precious body offered to us at every Eucharist. In our confusion and disappointments, when we do not know what to do, God bestows his comforter, the Holy Spirit. May we be always open to receive that help, and especially so at Pentecost, when we are given a special chance to share in Christ's glory, who stooped down to us that we might be lifted to God.


