From the Pastor

Dear Friends,

The First Communion Class returned Sunday, May 14th at the 8:30am Mass for the May Crowning. It was a beautiful way to celebrate Mother's Day and Motherhood as we crowned our Blessed Mother Mary, the Queen of the Apostles!

Monday is Memorial Day. It is much more than a three-day weekend that marks the beginning of summer. To many people, especially the nation's thousands of combat veterans, this day, which has a history stretching back all the way to the Civil War, is an important reminder of those who died in the service of their country. Memorial Day was originally known Decoration Day because it was a time set aside to honor the nation's Civil War dead by decorating their graves. It was first widely observed on May 30, 1868, to commemorate the sacrifices of Civil War soldiers, by proclamation of General John A. Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic, an organization of former sailors and soldiers. Let us take the time this weekend to recall the lives of our loved ones who have gone before us and have given the ultimate sacrifice of service to our nation. We should all take a moment to bow our heads in prayer for the safety of all our men and women in our armed services.

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, the 50th day of our Easter season. We just heard in the Book of Acts how the Holy Spirit was given to the followers of Jesus. People from all over the world who were in Jerusalem for the Jewish Festival of Pentecost were surprised to hear someone speaking their own language so far from home. Parthians and Libyans and residents of Mesopotamia, in other words, everyone from the known world, all were ecstatic about the mighty acts of God. Before the day was done the church had grown. Soon these followers were able to speak as Jesus did, and they were able to bring healing to those who were sick. God's breath now gave them new life. It was time for God to be born again, not in one body, but this time but in a body of believers who would receive the breath of life from their Lord and pass it on to others.

The real lesson today of the Holy Spirit is to be open, to listen, to follow the promptings given out of sincere prayer. Like Christ, the Spirit moves and prompts us to move on to the way forward to His Father. As the world moves on, the Spirit prompts us to move with it. Over centuries of difficult learning the church and humanity has gradually learned the need to be open and to grow with the times and the unfolding of the wonders of creation as we get to know them better. Christ said the Spirit would teach them everything they would need to know, but first we must be open and listen and discern what the Spirit is helping us to understand. It is the Spirit who brings us to Jesus' path to the Father. Like any path, it needs to be fresh and clear and ready for travel. Jesus led the way, and the Spirit keeps it prepared for us.

We are amid the Commencement season where colleges and universities are finishing up their festivities while high school and elementary schools are just beginning to honor the accomplishments of their students. We want to join many in expressing high praise and best wishes to all those who are graduating. So, to all of our students who clearly are enjoying their graduation highlights, we extend our prayerful best wishes to you while wishing you a wonderful summer of refreshment time. Stay Safe!


