From the Pastor

Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. The Trinity is the heart and soul of our faith. The feast of the Holy Trinity reminds us that every Sunday's gospel helps unfold the mystery of divine life: in each gospel, Jesus makes the Father's truth and love present in the world through the power of the Holy Spirit. Every Sunday's Eucharist is the prayer of the church in living communion with the Risen Lord praising the Father through the power of the Spirit. Every good work we do is to share in Christ's mission of making the Father's truth and love present in the world because we share Christ's Spirit.

Today's feast invites us to live in the awareness of the presence of the Triune God within us: The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The mystery of the Holy Trinity, a doctrine proclaimed by the ecumenical councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, is one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity and the greatest mystery of our Faith, namely, that there are Three Divine Persons, sharing the same Divine nature in one "There is one God, who has three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each Person is God, yet there is still only one God" (CCC #234, #253-256). We have Father Who is the Creator, Son, the Redeemer and Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier and the Counselor. The doctrine of Three Persons in one God, equal in Divinity yet distinct in Person, is not explicitly spelt out in the Bible. Even the very word "Trinity" is not found in the Bible. But the doctrine of the Trinity underlies all major including Christian feasts, Christmas, Epiphany, Good Friday, Easter, the Ascension and Pentecost. All the official prayers of the Church, including the Holy Mass and the Sacraments, begin with an address to the Holy Trinity: "In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." We are baptized, absolved of our sins and anointed in the name of the Blessed Trinity. We

bless ourselves with the Sign of the Cross invoking the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and we conclude our prayers glorifying the Holy Trinity, saying "Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit."

I join with Msgr. Sheahan; Msgr. Theroux; Msgr. Kenney and Deacon Albanese, as we extend our Congratulations and Prayers to all who have graduated from Colleges and Universities during the Month of May. Also, we pray for all those that are graduating from High School. May the good work that God has begun in each of you be brought to completion!

Church celebrates the Feast of Corpus Christi (Body of Christ) on Sunday, June 11th. At the conclusion of the 8:30am Mass, Father will carry, in solemn procession, the MONSTRANCE containing the Blessed Sacrament (Body of Christ) from the Church around the EXTERIOR grounds, and then back to the altar for Benediction. Everyone follows in solemn procession behind the Blessed Sacrament and joins the choir in singing Eucharistic hymns. You will be directed in and out of the Church by parish staff. This is a special way to honor the Blessed Sacrament which is carried under a canopy. In particular, we invite ALL altar servers and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist to join us in that procession, as well as all present in Church at the 8:30am Mass. We walk in reverence and respect following Father and the Blessed Sacrament. The procession will be brief but powerful as the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist is, on this rare occasion, taken outside the confines of our church walls. Hope you consider joining us for this brief, traditional ceremony as we honor the Blessed Sacrament - the source and summit of the Christian life.


