# From the Pastor

Dear Friends,

As you gather this weekend at Holy Apostles for the celebration of Mass, you realize that I am not with you this weekend. I am with the other members of Holy Apostles Parish on our Mission Trip to Blessed Assurance Orphanage in Jamaica. I ask for your prayers and please be assured that you are in our prayers.

Mary, Queen of Apostles... pray for us!

This Sunday we celebrate Father's Day. It is believed that this day of tribute began because Mrs. John B. Dodd, born Sonora Smart, of Spokane, Washington, was so thankful for her father that she pushed for an annual Father's Day Observance in 1909. Her own father was a civil war veteran and was widowed when his wife died in childbirth. He was left with six children to raise. Mrs. Dodd began circulating petitions and within a year, the city of Spokane agreed to honor Fathers on the 3rd Sunday in June, close to her father's birthday. Meanwhile, cities and towns all across America began to celebrate Father's Day. The idea became so popular that others joined in her crusade. In 1924, President Calvin Coolidge backed the idea of a national Father's Day and in 1966, President Lyndon Johnson declared Father's Day a national holiday. President Richard Nixon signed it into the books in 1972.

We should all take the time this weekend to Thank God for the gift of Fathers. Through the intercession of Saint Joseph, we pray in a special way for those that are living and those gone before us in faith.

On the 24<sup>th</sup> June the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist, and on 29 August, we will celebrate the memorial of his martyrdom. There is no other saint for whom the Church celebrates both of these moments. Generally, it celebrates only their "birth into heaven", with the exception, of course, of

Jesus, the Son of God (25 December – his birth; and Good Friday – his death) and the Virgin Mary (8 September – her birth; and 15 August – her Assumption into heaven). Jesus himself said, "Amen, I say to you, among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist" (Mt. 11:11). He was the last of the great prophets of Israel, the first to testify to Jesus, who initiated a baptism for the forgiveness of sins and, in this context, baptized Jesus; he was a martyr who died defending the Judaic law. As early as the 4th century, we find a liturgical commemoration for Saint John the Baptist celebrated on a variety of dates. The date of 24 June was established based on Lk 1:36a where speaking of Elizabeth it says, "this is the sixth month for her who was called barren", therefore, six months before Christmas.

#### Blessing for Father's

God, our Father, Bless these men, that they may find strength as fathers. Let the example of their faith and love shine forth. Grant that we, their sons and daughters,

may honor them always with a spirit of profound respect.






