Dear Friends,

After a very quick and busy Summer here at Holy Apostles we are beginning a new year of Religious Education classes and many other activities here on the Campus of Holy Apostles Parish. I wish to express my gratitude for the wonderful and faith-filled programs and activities that took place here during the summer. The VBS was truly outstanding and enjoyed by all the participants. Our weeks of Religious Education for our various classes were well attended and the sharing of the knowledge of our faith was well received by all. Our Teen retreat was a tremendous showing of a faith community that is truly being enriched by the young members of Holy Apostles Parish. On August 20th we celebrated 25 years of our Teen Ministry here at Holy Apostles. Our celebration began with a "Teen Mass" at 5:00pm with Monsignor Sheahan as the principal celebrant; Monsignor Theroux, Fr. Forcier and I concelebrated the Mass. I was the homilist for the Mass. The music was provided by our Teen Choir, under the direction of Mark Colozzi. It was an outstanding celebration in honor of the teen program for the past 25 years, including the 13 missionary groups. The tented reception on the front lawn of Holy Apostles Church was a wonderful way for over 500 of the faithful to share stories about how Apostles Parish has made a true difference in their faith journey. My thanks to all the volunteers that made that Sunday so special.

This Friday, September 29th is the Feast of the Archangels. The liturgy celebrates the feast of these three archangels who are venerated in the tradition of the Church. Michael (Who is like God?) was the archangel who fought against Satan and all his evil angels, defending all the friends of God. He is the protector of all humanity from the snares of the devil. Gabriel (Strength of God) announced to Zachariah the forthcoming birth of John the Baptist, and to Mary, the birth of Jesus. His greeting to the Virgin, "Hail, full of grace," is one of the most familiar and frequent prayers of the Christian people. Raphael (Medicine of God) is the archangel who took care of Tobias on his journey.

St. Michael

The name of the archangel Michael means, in Hebrew, who is like unto God? and he is also known as "the prince of the heavenly host." He is usually pictured as a strong warrior, dressed in armor and wearing sandals. His name appears in Scripture four times, twice in the Book of Daniel, and once each in the Epistle of St. Jude and the Book of Revelation. From Revelation we learn of the battle in heaven, with St. Michael and his angels combating Lucifer and the other fallen angels (or devils). We invoke St. Michael to help us in our fight against Satan; to rescue souls from Satan, especially at the hour of death; to be the champion of the Jews in the Old Testament and now Christians; and to bring souls to judgment.

St. Gabriel

St. Gabriel's name means "God is my strength". Biblically he appears three times as a messenger. He had been sent to Daniel to explain a vision concerning the Messiah. He appeared to Zachary when he was offering incense in the Temple, to foretell the birth of his son, St. John the Baptist. St. Gabriel is most known as the angel chosen by God to be the messenger of the Annunciation, to announce to mankind the mystery of the Incarnation. The angel's salutation to our Lady, so simple and yet so full of meaning, *Hail Mary, full of grace*, has become the constant and familiar prayer of all Christian people.

St. Raphael

Our knowledge of the Archangel Raphael comes to us from the book of Tobit. His mission as wonderful healer and fellow traveler with the youthful Tobias has caused him to be invoked for journeys and at critical moments in life. Tradition also holds that Raphael is the angel that stirred the waters at the healing sheep pool in Bethesda. His name means "God has healed".

"God our Father, in a wonderful way you guide the work of angels and men. May those who serve you constantly in heaven keep our lives safe from all harm on earth. Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen." Opening Collect for the Feast of the Archangels
