Dear Friends,


This Monday we celebrate Columbus Day, which honors Christopher Columbus' first voyage to America in 1492. Columbus Day became a legal federal holiday in the United States in 1971. It is celebrated on the second Monday in October. Before 1971, a number of states celebrated Columbus Day on October 12. The first Columbus Day celebration was held in 1792, when New York City celebrated the 300th anniversary of the landing. In 1892, President Benjamin Harrison called upon the people of the United States to celebrate Columbus Day on the 400th anniversary of the event. Columbus Day has been celebrated annually since 1920.

Although it is generally accepted that Columbus was Christopher the European to have discovered the New World of the Americas, there is still some controversy over this claim. Some researchers and proponents of other explorers attribute the first sightings to the early Scandinavian Vikings or the voyages of Irish missionaries, which predate the Columbus visit in 1492. The controversy may never be fully resolved to everyone's satisfaction, but 1992 marked the 500th anniversary of the Columbus discovery.

October is designated by the U.S. Bishops as Pro-Life Month. As a Church we are asked to pray for an end to abortion and an increase in respect for all human life. Let us all join in praying for life as we offer this prayer:

"Heavenly Father, You called us in baptism to be messengers of the Good News; through your Apostle Paul, you reminded us not to conform to the spirit of the age, but rather to seek to do what is good, pleasing and perfect in Your sight. Give us courage, we humbly pray, to live our vocations to the fullest on our journey through life; keep us vigilant in defense of the weakest and most vulnerable of your children, especially those at life's fragile beginnings and endings. Give us the strength to build a civilization of life and love here on earth, even as we await the coming of Your kingdom. We ask you this in the name of your Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ." Amen.

FIRST COMMUNION PROGRAM PARENT MEETING


