From the Pastor

Dear Friends,

This week, we begin 34 weeks of "Ordinary Time," which are all of the weeks outside of the Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter seasons. Ordinary Time will continue until Ash Wednesday on February 14. In this first weekend of Ordinary Time, we might find ourselves feeling a little letdown after the Christmas season, especially in parts of the world where it seems cold and dark most days. This is where we can ask for the grace to let the stories of the gospels come alive in our hearts.

The Sunday gospel is the story of Jesus calling two more apostles, asking them, and us, "What are you looking for?" We may read this passage today as a fitting introduction to the entire season of Ordinary Time, in which the invitation to discipleship and to the life and ministry of Jesus are repeatedly offered as the subjects of our prayer, action, and reflection. is a good week for us to contemplate with Jesus, what we are looking for and how much we want to turn and follow him. We can pray to Jesus for the strength to leave the patterns and habits of our lives that so often turn us away from him and ask for the grace to make a new beginning in our lives. If we can sit with our hands open in humility, we can accept that we cannot do this on our own, but know in our hearts that with the help of God, nothing is impossible. When Jesus enters our lives with the gentle call of his grace, how will we reply? Will we be busy with other

things, afraid he will ask too much of us? Or will we trust him? Will we be open to his call and a new beginning in our lives? In the gospel Jesus says to the apostles: "Come, and you will see."

Let this "New Year" be a time of great improvement in each of our lives; may the joy that we experienced during the Christmas Season be with us throughout the year. May we accept his invitation to "Come and See" in this New Year and may we invite others to do the same.



Weekday Masses are \$10 Weekend Masses are \$25 Altar Bread /Sanctuary Lamps are \$20


