Dear Friends,

We begin the month of November with the celebration of the *Solemnity of All Saints* on Saturday, November 1<sup>st</sup> and The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed: *All Souls Day* on Sunday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>.

All Saints Day is a surprisingly old feast. It arose out of the Christian tradition of celebrating the martyrdom of saints on the anniversary of their martyrdom. When martyrdoms increased during the persecutions of the late Roman Empire, local dioceses instituted a common feast day in order to ensure that all martyrs, known and unknown were properly honored. Our late Holy Father Pope Francis on Nov. 1, 2015 the feast of All Saints, celebrated Mass at the Verano cemetery in Rome, he stated: "today's celebration, the Feast of All Saints, we experience in a special way the reality of the communion of saints, our great family that consists of all members of the Church, both those of us who are still pilgrims on earth, and the immense multitude of those who have already left and gone to Heaven. We are all united, and this is called the "communion of saints", meaning the community of all baptized people... Imitating their gestures of love and mercy is a bit like perpetuating their presence in this world. These evangelical gestures are indeed the only ones that can withstand the destruction of death: an act of tenderness, generous aid, time spent listening, a visit, a kind word, a smile.... In our eyes these gestures might seem insignificant, but in the eyes of God they are eternal, because love and compassion are stronger than death. May the Virgin Mary, Queen of All Saints, help us to trust more in the grace of God, and to walk with enthusiasm along the path of holiness." Vatican City November 1, 2015

In the early centuries, this feast was celebrated in the Easter season. The current date of November 1 was instituted by Pope Gregory III (731-741), when he consecrated a chapel to all the martyrs in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome and ordered an annual celebration. This celebration was originally confined to the diocese of Rome, but Pope Gregory IV (827-844) extended the feast to the entire Church and ordered it to be celebrated on November 1.

All Souls Day reminds us that it's good to speak about the dead, and to remember and to pray. The Church commemorates the faithful departed and invites us, the living, to pray for their eternal repose in the peace of Christ's Kingdom. Our late Holy Father Pope Francis stated in his All-Soul's homily in 2018: "Today's liturgy is realistic, it is concrete. It is part of the three dimensions of life, dimensions that even children understand: the past, the future, the present. Today is a day of memory of the past, a day to remember those who walked before us, who also accompanied us, gave us life. Remember, remember. Memory is what makes a people strong because it feels rooted in a journey, rooted in a history, rooted in a people. Memory makes us understand that we are not alone, we are a people: a people that has history, that has passed, that has life. Memory of many who have shared a journey with us..." Laurentin Cemetery in Rome on All Souls Day, November 2, 2018.

Let us pray in a special way not only for our loved ones who have died, but also for all those who count on the charity of our prayers.


