From the Pastor

Dear Friends.

We celebrate this weekend what is popularly called the Feast of Christ the King (the official Church name is *The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe*). As always, we commemorate the fact that our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is indeed the King of the Universe. During the last twelve months we have followed the life of Jesus from the prophesies of last Advent, through his birth, public ministry, death and resurrection. We have prayed over the message of His life as well as His teachings.

In his encyclical establishing this observation in the Church (this only occurred in 1925, some 98years ago) Pope Pius XI declared, "He (Jesus) must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God.

The Kingdom of God is a time and an opportunity. The kingdom of God becomes real whenever anyone of us provides food for hungry people and whenever we support those who offer shelter to a homeless person. In the Preface of today's feast, we acknowledge that Christ's kingdom is to be a universal kingdom of truth and life, of holiness and grace, justice, love and peace. Whenever these are forces in our lives then we are living in Christ's kingdom.

This Thursday, our Nation pauses as we celebrate Thanksgiving Day. Thanksgiving offers us a welcome pause in our busy schedule to stop and take stock of the many things, normally taken for granted, that we are especially grateful for. There is the obvious: family, friends, health and prosperity, and the easily forgotten: our nation's bounty, God's grace and the joys and the challenges of daily living. Thanksgiving is also a reminder to us of our need to be generous to those who have not been so greatly blessed.

In both small and great ways, we as a community of faith have much to be thankful for this week. As we gather as a Parish Family to thank Almighty God who has blessed us so abundantly, we also thank those who work so hard

for our Parish and those who have been so generous. I join with Msgr. Sheahan, Msgr. Theroux, Msgr. Kenney, Deacon Albanese and Holy Apostles Parish Staff as we extend our prayers to you and your families on this Thanksgiving Day. We invite you to join with us on Thanksgiving Morning at 9:00am for the celebration of Holy Mass. We will remember in a special way all those that have died during this past year and pray for all the sick in our parish especially, those in our Nursing and care facilities. I invite a member of each family to offer this prayer before your Thanksgiving Dinner.
