Dear Friends,

Today marks the second Sunday of Advent, and so we await the celebration of Christmas, and await the coming of the Lord. But this waiting is not a passive time. For most of us, the Advent season is filled with preparations. We're buying gifts, decorating our homes, baking and cooking up a storm. We are readying ourselves to celebrate Christmas with our family and friends. It is indeed a busy, yet joyous time. This joyous preparation ought to extend into the depths of our hearts. Remember, we are not preparing to simply exchange gifts or even to just spend time with family and friends. We are preparing to celebrate the incarnation, God becoming man for our sake - one of the greatest mysteries of our Faith. At the same time, we are preparing to greet The Lord when He comes again. Therefore, we must spend time preparing spiritually. This weekend's Scripture readings encourage us to prepare ourselves and to bear witness to the world of God's greatness while we wait.

Indeed, our lives should bear witness to the great things the Lord has done, and the things He continues to do. We are called to proclaim His praises boldly by the way we live our lives – giving Him glory in all we say and do. As stewards, the Advent season is a wonderful time to refocus. Increase the time you spend in prayer, thanking God for the gift of Himself as we prepare to celebrate Christmas, thanking God for the innumerable gifts He has given us, and offering Him yourself in return. Recommit to live for Him. Then your life will surely bear witness of the mighty things He has done, and your heart will be ready to greet Him when He comes again.

This Monday is the Feast of The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We celebrate our belief that Mary, even before she was born, was free from sin from the moment of her conception. This is a privilege accorded to her because she bore the Son of God, but it no doubt is also a privilege because she was always open to God's word for her and the direction her life should take. The idea of Mary's complete sinless- ness was first expressed in the earliest Christian centuries, and in 1854 Pope Pius IX proclaimed it a dogma. The solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is the patronal feast for

the United States. Through the Intercession of our Mary, we pray that she will continue to guide us in our earthly ministry.

This Friday, we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe; In 1531 a "Lady from Heaven" appeared to a humble Native American at Tepeyac, a hill northwest of what is now Mexico City. She identified herself as the ever-virgin Holy Mary, Mother of the True God for whom we live, of the Creator of all things, Lord of heaven and the earth. She made a request for a church to be built on the site and submitted her wish to the local Bishop. When the Bishop hesitated, and requested her for a sign, the Mother of God obeyed without delay or question to the Church's local Bishop and sent her native messenger to the top of the hill in mid-December to gather an assortment of roses for the Bishop. After complying to the Bishop's request for a sign, she also left for us an image of herself imprinted miraculously on the native's tilma, a poor quality cactus-cloth, which should have deteriorated in 20 years but shows no sign of decay 480 years later and still defies all scientific explanations of its origin.

It apparently even reflects in Her eyes what was in front of her in 1531. Her message of love and compassion, and her universal promise of help and protection to all mankind, as well as the story of the apparitions, are described in the "Nican Mopohua", a 16th century document written in the native Nahuatl language. There is reason to believe that at Tepeyac Mary came in her glorified body, and her actual physical hands rearranged the roses in Juan Diego's tilma, which makes this apparition very special. An incredible list of miracles, cures and interventions are attributed to Her. Yearly, between 18 - 20 million pilgrims visit the Basilica, making it Christianity's most visited sanctuary.
