
I confess to almighty God


GOSPEL Mark 16:1-7

When the women visit the tomb, an angel of the Lord comes and rolls away the stone. He speaks to them, telling them of Jesus' resurrection.











Israel passed through the Red Sea unharmed. As for the Egyptians, their horses and chariots were tossed into the sea.




