Corpus Christi is partnered with St Joseph's Catholic Church in Lebanon, IL

Though each church maintains its individuality, the partnership committee and office staffs continually find ways to come together on numerous fronts. Besides sharing a priest, the partnership shares a liturgical committee who help organize combined liturgical events throughout the year such as Holy Week, Partnership Mass & Picnic, and Outdoor Mass with Blessing of Pets to name a few. Our combined youth group for children from 7th—12th grade kicked off in late 2024 with events such as flashlight Easter Egg Hunt, Gingerbread House building, and movie night. Both parishes support and donate numerous hours and copious amounts of food to the Joseph House program held at St Joseph's rectory for McKendree University students. Also both churches come together in support of multiple outreach projects for St Vincent de Paul, Catholic Urban Programs, Pregnancy Cares, Boxes of Joy and such.

Parish School of Religion

Our Parish School of Religion (PSR) is a partnership between the parish & your family. You are the primary educators of your child, and the PSR program encourages each child & family to explore and develop their faith and Catholic identity together.

PSR sessions are from 10-11AM on Sundays. The PSR year runs from the 4th Sunday in August through the 1st Sunday of May. Classes are offered for Grades K-8th.

Throughout the PSR year, there are various activities that PSR students and their families are invited to and encouraged to participate in. These activities include Children's Masses where students provide the ministries, Advent & Lent Outreach Projects, Stations of the Cross, and Fall/Spring Family Sessions.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLW) takes place during the 9 AM Mass for children ages 3 years old thru 2nd grade. The program is open to parishioners and visitors. CLW is offered from the 2nd Sunday in August through the 2nd Sunday of May.
