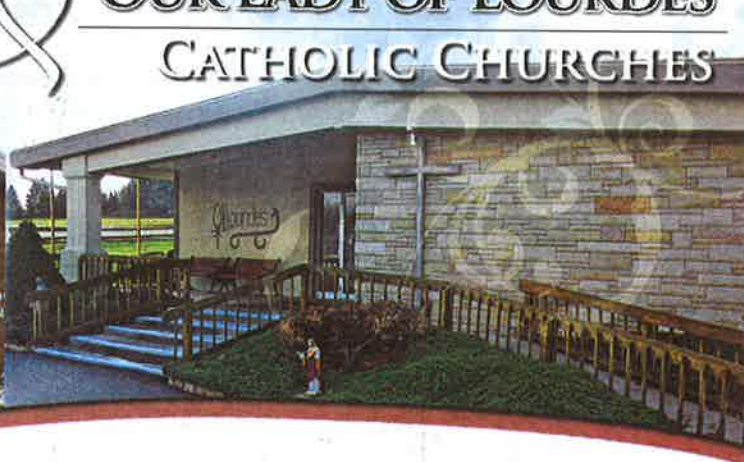

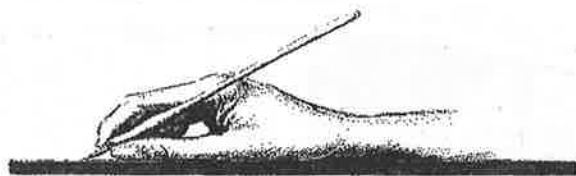

***The four living creatures answered, "Amen,"  
and the elders fell down and worshipped.***

(pertaining to today's second reading: Revelation 5:11-14)

A lion, a man, an ox, and an eagle. These are the four living creatures in John's vision that represent the gospel evangelists. Mark is depicted as a lion. His gospel begins with John the Baptist roaring in the wilderness. Matthew shows a human face, because his gospel begins with the genealogy of Jesus' human ancestry. Luke is represented by an ox because the temple sacrifice offered by Zechariah opens the narrative. John is the eagle. His gospel soars to the heavens and seems to have the eagle-eyed capacity to see into the depths of what's true. These creatures answer *Amen*, which means "so be it," to praise for the glory of God. The gospels we have today are the great *Amen* of these inspired authors. Through their written accounts of the life, mission, passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus, we all get the chance to add our own *Amen*. (Alice Camille)

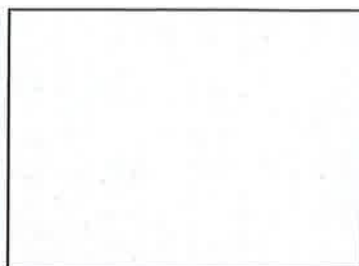

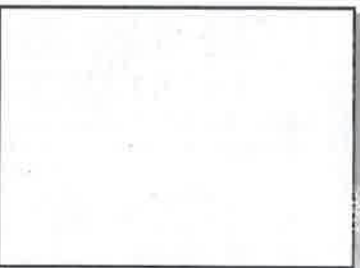

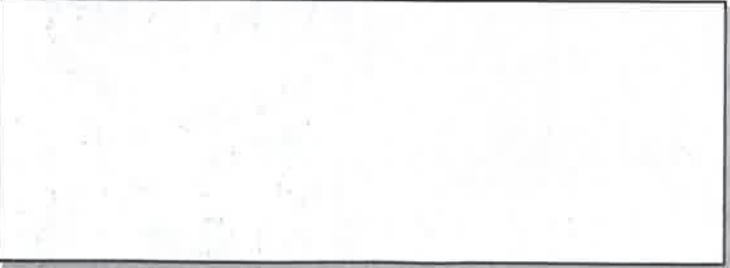
