FR. MICHAEL SAYS.....

Once again, we are just days away from starting the season of Lent.

No matter what is going on in your life or what you feel about your relationship with God, Lent is an incredible opportunity to choose the Lord in a new way.

Every year, we make choices about how we will personally practice Lent: what to give up, what to take on, how to pray, how to spend our time. All these choices should have the goal of helping us put the Lord first in our lives by repenting of our sins.

The opening prayer for mass on Ash Wednesday reads: "Grant, O Lord, that we may begin with holy fasting this campaign of Christian service, so that, as we take up battle against spiritual evils, we may be armed with weapons of self-restraint."

We do battle against spiritual evils with the weapons of almsgiving, fasting, and prayer. It would be helpful to take these next few days to spend time thinking and praying about what would be helpful for us to do this Lent.

Please remember, Lent is not about doing something hard just for its own sake or going on a diet - or even improving ourselves. It is a time to focus on God in a radical way so that we can be open to what only He can do.

Start this season by coming to mass on Ash Wednesday. The times for mass are listed in the bulletin.

We will also begin praying the Stations of the Cross every Friday during Lent. Beginning this Friday, March 4, the stations will be held at 3:00pm, at Blessed Sacrament and 7:00pm, at Our Lady of Lourdes.

We will continue to hold Eucharistic Adoration on Wednesdays from 5:30pm to 8:30pm at Blessed Sacrament.

<u>IMPORTANT FOR ALTAR SERVERS</u>

We are looking for new altar servers at Blessed Sacrament. Any children who have received their first communion are welcome. We will hold **training sessions** for **new and old** servers on three dates:

March 5, at 1:00pm, March 12 at 9:30am, and March 19 at 9:30am. All of these are on Saturdays.
