

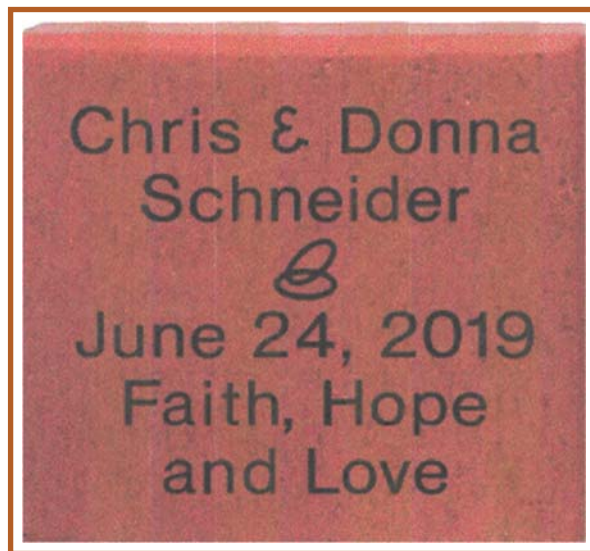
You are invited to purchase bricks in three sizes:

4" x 8" ♦ 8" x 8" ♦ 12" x 12"

Each 4" x 8" brick may include up to three lines with a limit of 14 characters per line. Larger bricks may contain additional lines.

Up to two symbols may also be added to further personalize a brick. Each symbol requires four character spaces.

## ***The Beauty of St. Paul the Apostle Parish Is Now Brought Outdoors!***

Most everyone agrees that the interior of our church is beautiful. Now we are working on bringing that splendor beyond our walls to the grounds outside our church building.

Late in 2021, we plan to install a five-foot tall fiberglass statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary, resting atop a base and foundation, on the west side of the parish grounds near the pond. This statue will be a creation of *Inspired Artisans of Milwaukee*.

In 2022, we will create the Rosary Garden around our Blessed Virgin Mary statue. The beads of the rosary will be engraved into bricks surrounding the statue.



Additionally, the garden will be graced with trees, benches and a brick walkway to and around the garden.

Once completed, the Rosary Garden will offer a unique prayer space that will enhance the charm and appeal of St. Paul the Apostle Church.
