- Review of the minutes from last meeting: Approved as written
- Pastor's report:
  - Parish Leadership team: Year of the Disciple. Encourage people to be intentional with the path of discipleship. Start with the staff and building community there
  - Air purifier response: Well exceeded the amount needed. We got close to \$16,000 extra, which will go toward tuition assistance because that is a larger need this year.
  - Financial update: We are where we expected to be at this point in the year. We had budgeted on a loss. PPP and other federal aid will be a help this year.
- School report: School is going well, so far no positive cases. Enrollment is down this year. There is a lot of fluctuation this year.
- Parish Vision: Made for Mission Ch4. The vision should reflect where we want to go, not where we currently are. The mission of parishes should be evangelization. Our parish vision is “Everyone we meet encounters and follows Jesus Christ”.
- Summer social: What is its purpose and what should it look like moving forward? Is it a fundraiser or a way to build community both within our parish and community? We see the community aspect as being essential. The social is important for the sake of community.
- Evangelization Coordinator Search Update: Still looking, do we reopen the search and broaden it?
- Phone calls to parishioners: Still need some groups to be taken. Many people we talked to are upbeat and doing well.
