- Review of the minutes from last meeting: Approved as written
- Pastor's report:
- Question of how to use the back 40 space behind Holy Spirit.
 - o Joe Keifer with Hahn Reality, realtor familiar with sale of church property.
 - Litech Development- Company that specializes in high quality low income housing has expressed interest in building low-income apartments
 - o 3.8 acres for development
 - Land is currently not used except for baseball diamond which is no longer used
 - Currently time and money is used to mow and maintain
 - Proposal for layout of apartments was provided to the Council
 - The intention is to ask for at least \$50,000 per acre
 - Process to follow
 - Two appraisals from companies- in progress
 - Talk to councils (parish and finance) and provide a list of pros and cons
 - o Pros:
 - Financial gains
 - Elimination of eyesore
 - Elimination of maintenance
 - Creates a possibility for families living there to attend the school
 - Increased security of area along border (would be condition of sale to add trees and or fence)
 - o Cons:
 - Once the land is sold, we can't get it back
 - Other areas to be addressed:
 - Changes in current proposed layout needed to best use the space
 - Rezoning would be needed
 - Parking and sidewalks would be needed
 - Proximity to streets and houses
 - Questions
 - Timeline? Litech is willing to move on this. There is a possibility that the company would submit by summer and we would receive funds at that time or in early fall
 - How can we engage with the people living there?/What are their needs?
 - Is it possible they would buy the land and not build it? Probably not
