- Review of the minutes from last meeting: approved as written
- Pastor's report:
 - Parish Pictorial Directory. Last one was in 2015. It was approved to start the process for 2020 publication.
 - o Penance Service, April 4, 6 p.m.
 - o Cash Flow Forecast for April, May, and June. Next fiscal year's budget process has begun to tighten numbers. The tuition adjustment should shift next year's numbers.
 - O Sale of Land. Diocesan Finance Council met today. Goal: close before end of fiscal year.
 - Infrastructure Issues: Roof for rectory will need to be replaced. Sliding doors on rectory have a
 gap causing a leak. Garage door. Upstairs air conditioning. These will need to be addressed in
 future budgets.
 - o Goal: help school families find social support as needed to stay in schools.

 - Consensus refer cash flow and numbers to Finance Council for clearer picture of finance projection for end of fiscal year. Request for a Finance Committee member to attend the next Parish Council meeting with updates.
 - o Council requests an updated cash flow forecast for end of fiscal year.
- Sense of Belonging Vision Committee report
 - Summer Social June 14-15. Planning is going well. This year's raffle will include early bird drawings.
 - o More health & safety training is in the planning stages.

 - O Goal: help parish families get together and play during the summer, based on things already happening in the area.
 - Music in the Park

 - o Fun in Faith
 - o Hike at Harmony State Park April 27, led by Jim and Jan Ware with a picnic lunch
