 Revamping the room in the Parish Center to be dubbed "The Upper Room".
- Pastor's Report
 - Installation of video equipment in church partially complete. Still need cameras and adapters but the system will work with Fr. Alex's current camera.

- Set a time for late Summer retreat for Parish Council: Saturday, August 8th during the morning.
