### Guidance for safe and reverent liturgy

The obligation to attend Sunday Mass **resumes on June 11, 2021**. There are some exceptions noted in a document on our parish website.

#### General notes

- All people should be responsible for their own health and wellbeing. This may require some who are at risk to take additional precautions.
- We continue to emphasize that those who show symptoms of COVID-19 should stay home.
- Face masks are not required for those who have been vaccinated. Those who feel more comfortable wearing a mask are obviously welcome to continue to do so.

#### What we will continue **NOT** doing

- The physical sign of peace. A non-contact sign of peace (such as a wave or bow of the head) will serve as a replacement in the interim.
- Communion from the chalice

#### What to expect when coming to church

- All people should enter through the main door to church.
- SEATING:
  - On the **RIGHT** side of the church (as you face the altar) **every other pew will remain blocked off**. We encourage you to respect social distancing of 3 feet on this side.
  - On the **LEFT** side of church (as you face the altar) **every pew may be used**. No social distancing is necessary.
- Missalettes will soon be available in the pews at CTK or on the bookshelves at HS. **If you took a missalette**, please bring it back to church and leave it in your pew or on the bookshelf at HS.
- Everyone should use the hand sanitizer located at the entrance to the church as you enter or bring your own.
- A collection basket will be available in the rear of the church for your offering.
- The Communion minister is required to sanitize his/her hands after giving Communion on the tongue.
- Water fountains will not be available for use.
- Holy water will once again be available.
