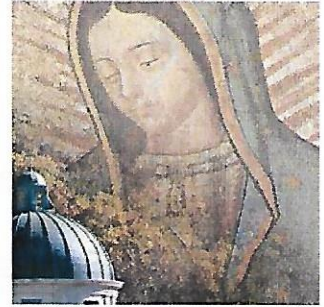


Join us on a Marian Pilgrimage to **The Rudolph Grotto Gardens,**
