- E. **Mission Trip:** TBA (will schedule after COVID-19 is gone.)

- G. **Respect Life**: No report. Discussion regarding a "Human Trafficking" workshop at the direction of two Green Bay nuns, resulted in generating interest toward possibly collaborating with the UU to hold the workshops. Monika will be consulted via e-mail.
- H. **St. Vincent DePaul Society**: \$250. In donations. January and February visits were nineteen. \$5,085.00 was dispersed.

New Business:
