Parish Mission Planning/Entrust - Jan: Entrust has started two small groups. Outreach has suggested saying the Rosary in public, possibly at a local Farmer's Market.

Respect for Life - Beckie: The Committee continues on hiatus but is still submitting Respect Life articles for the church bulletin.

St Vincent de Paul - Jan: Twenty visits have been made since our May meeting. A member spoke after Masses two weekends ago.

FAMily Program - Jan: CSR members who had helped host the events at different church sites had positive feedback.

Box of Joy - Kristy: Boxes and info will be ready for our September meeting for the project to be held in October.

Jan reminded us of the Parish Mission Goals: 1. Discipleship Formation - people to be missionary disciples; 2. Building connections with people thru love of Jesus and 3. Community engagement and impact.
