D. Mission trip: Jan Liss and a grandmother/granddaughter went to St. John's shelter in Green Bay, where they organized and sorted donations of socks and other items.

E. Parish Mission Planning: Jan Malchow reported via e-mail that the workbook/analysis/goals etc effort is continuing. This is an effort to get a discipleship plan of what Stella Maris parish is going to do to ensure a loving relationship with Christ.

F. Pastoral Council: Pastoral Council: The pastoral council is finishing up the annual report. The process to replace Katrina Welborn is on-going. She has resigned in order to further her University studies.

G. Respect Life: Monika has submitted bulletin articles regarding the status of the group.

H. St. Vincent DePaul Society: Greg and Tammy report that they have served 25 people in need, spending \$8,900.00. A \$10,000. Donation was given by a generous donor. The group is planning to partake in a "Friends of the Poor" walk on 9/25, which is a nationwide walk.
