- The group debriefed on goals accomplished this year and talked about goals for 2020. Becky will prepare a 2020 calendar-year plan based on the discussion.
- The group decided that Pat, Becky and Tom would all be co-leaders of this committee. We will help each other attend to whatever meetings or submissions are required of a committee leader. We will also continue to enlist new members.
