# 2023 Service and Sharing Drive (SSD)

### **Critique and Resultant Action Items:**

- A new committee was formed because of a suggestion on the brochure: the Safety Committee.
- Additional people volunteered. (see below for details)
- Brochure was well received. The QR codes will need to be changed for next year's brochure. We will need to bring Kevin into the process earlier.
- Tom will send Bernie the suggested changes to the brochure. Jody will assist Bernie in implementing the changes.
- New volunteers' information was sent to the appropriate ministry leaders who, in turn, contacted the new volunteers for their ministry.
- Deacon suggested having an additional person (a 4th person) to input data from the cards/brochures into the spreadsheet for the 2024 S & S Drive.
- The details of the 2024 Service and Sharing Drive will be worked out at a special meeting on April 2, 2024.

# **Service and Sharing Drive Response Details:**

- We currently have 377 active volunteers.
- 145 brochures were returned, which is less than previous years. It was suggested that some people only returned the stewardship cards to indicate their financial pledge and not to volunteer. However, separating the financial portion from the volunteer portion did not seem to have a negative impact on donations.
- Twenty-two new households filled out brochures.

### **Additional Discussion and Action Items:**

- It was decided that November is a good time to distribute the financial commitment part.
- Tom, Jim and Laura will create a narrative budget with year-end numbers.

- The goal is to keep the Annual Meeting to 20 minutes.
- Next year the Stewardship Committee will invite the chairs of the Finance and Pastoral Councils to co-plan and co-host the event.
