Psalm 130 is the cry of a person buried by anguish. The psalm implies this anguish - - indeed all human anguish - - is caused by sin. In the course of the psalm, however, anguish becomes hope as we acknowledge that God's mercy surpasses all human sin. God will breathe new life into our souls and our bodies (*first reading*). Christ, "the resurrection and the life," will call us out of the tomb (*gospel*). The closer Jesus moves to his own death in Jerusalem, the more he reveals his power over death. The closer we move to Jesus, the more our redemption becomes real. ~ Kathleen Harmon
