## **OLD BUSINESS**

- Docks-ology 2018. was held on Wed. August 1<sup>st</sup> at the Ephraim Village hall due
  to rain. "Hope for the future" was the theme. Thank you to Father and Katrina
  plus all who helped in any way. <u>Comments</u> Debi said that it was nice how
  Katrina had a practice right before and we did not have to wait too long to get
  into the building.
- Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Masses held on Wed., August 15 in 8am EH, 12 noon in SB, 3pm on WI, and 7pm in FC. Comments - all went well and good attendance.
- **Update concerning deteriorating metal Communion cups.** Comment Katrina checked into it and said that we could re-plate the communion cups with silver, which is less expensive and lasts longer than gold plating. Gold, silver or pewter cups are all acceptable, with pewter lasting the longest.
- Update regarding the ushers handing out bulletins. Before Mass, bulletins should be placed near the front entrance, but not handed out. Michelle will work on ushers' description as a reminder for them and it will be sent out at a later date.
- Announcements at Mass and Bulletin Articles or Inserts. Bulletin articles and inserts should be sent to Lorie Orthober no later than Monday morning. Announcements should be sent to Katrina Welborn by Wednesday. If there is already information in that weekend's bulletin, there should be an abbreviated announcement which says to see more information in the bulletin.

- Advent/Christmas 2018 plans. Father Dave, Katrina, Mary, and Marian met in August to discuss and the Advent and Christmas seasons. See attached sheet.
- **Discussions and Decision on ordering Hymnals.** After discussion, it was decided to order *Gather 3* with accompaniment books for each site. We will begin using the new hymnals as the new church year begins in Advent.
- 2018-2019 Parish Calendar. Father Dave and Katrina worked on the calendar and will share any pertinent changes.

The St. Michael statue in Jacksonport is almost completed and will be dedicated soon. The statue of St. Paul will be placed in front of the bell tower in Fish Creek. # **ADVENT - CHRISTMAS 2018**

#### **GENERAL**

- Advent begins weekend of December 1-2
- ➤ Luke's Gospel
- > Readings are oriented towards Social Justice
- ➤ We'll once again use the banner created by Ryan Miller in 2015 featuring Mary and Elizabeth, the Magnificat.
- ➤ The Advent candles will be placed on a table covered with bluepurple fabric and fresh greens/wreath in the sanctuary. The Advent wreath will be built gradually over the 4 weeks. The wreath will be blessed after the opening song of the first week.
- ➤ A parishioner will be part of the opening procession, bringing up the lighted candle to add to the wreath each week. A short prayer will be read by the reader or the Deacon. Invitations to be a candle-bearer will appear in the bulletin and announcements during November. Michelle could also send something out through MSP. An instruction sheet will be available for the candle bearers so that they know exactly what to do.
- ➤ Hopefully, we'll have our new hymnals in the pews by Advent.

  Katrina will create a new blue worship guide which contains all the Mass settings which are not in the new hymnals plus all the songs we use from previous worship guides.
- ➤ We'll be singing the Mass of Light during the Advent season and the Mass of Creation during the Christmas season.
- ➤ The Kyrie will be sung each week of Advent.
- We'll recite the Apostles Creed rather than the Nicene Creed.
- The Universal Prayer response will be changed for the Advent / Christmas seasons.
- **Dec. 1-2** First Week of Advent Wreath is blessed after opening hymn.
- Dec. 7, Vigil Mass for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception Friday, 6:00 pm, Fish Creek
- Dec. 8, Mass for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception Saturday, 8:00 am, Sister Bay
